Postponement of 2019 - 2020 Annual General Meeting to the 31st of May

Due to the continuing uncertainty surrounding the easing of COVID-19 restrictions the Guild applied to the Department of Justice on the 4th of February for an extension of time to hold the 2019 - 2020 Annual General Meeting which was scheduled for 22 February 2021. We received approval from the Department of Justice to move the AGM to the 29th of March.

After we published news of that in issue number 112 of *Very Light* the Department of Justice sent a second approval which extended the postponement extension to the 31st of May, which therefore supersedes their approval for the 29th of March.

And further to that we are cancelling the scheduled February meeting for Monday the 22nd due to attendance limits imposed by ongoing COVID-19 restrictions.

Please note that as advised in issue 112 of *Very Light* the Guild is negotiating with the Department of Justice for permission to combine the 2019 – 2020 AGM with the 2020 -2021 AGM and hold this on the 30th of August. This would avoid the need to have two AGMs in 2021.

Another matter which we are addressing with the Department of Justice concerns the attendance caps imposed by the Whitehorse City Council which currently limits us to a maximum of 20 people in the hall. The Guild constitution does not allow us to limit the size of attendances at AGMs, so if we are unable to negotiate a new date for the AGM then we will be forced to hire a hall which allows a larger attendance.

We will advise members of any changes we will be forced to make.
